**ORDER OF THE MICHIGAN BARRIER FREE DESIGN BOARD**

On March 21, 2014 the Barrier Free Design Board reviewed the Report of the Administrative Law Judge dated February 27, 2014. All supplemental materials received before the Board meeting were reviewed. Copies were sent to all parties. This order is issued pursuant to Section 5(6)(a) of 1966 P.A. 1, as amended; 1972 P.A. 230, as amended; and Section 81 of 1969 of P.A. 306, as amended, and Rule R 125.1016.

**FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:** The Board adopted the report of the Administrative Law Judge. The Board concurs with the Conclusions of Law and Recommendation.

THEREFORE, it is the order of the Board to grant relief from the 2003 ICC/ANSI A117.1, Section 404.2.2 for the clear width of the two toilet room doors. FURTHERMORE, reviewing the photographs submitted along with the application the Board hereby advises the local building official to confirm compliance with 2003 ICC/ANSI A117.1, Chapter 3 and 6 for the protrusion of the drinking fountain, location of a vertical grab bar, location of the flush valve and the mounting height of the mirror.

The Board can only grant or deny exceptions to Michigan's barrier free design requirements. The Board has no authority over the federal standards contained in the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, 42 U.S.C. 12204.
