

BOILER INFORMATION - INSTALLERS EXAMINATION

In an effort to give you guidance as you prepare for the upcoming boiler examination, please read the following information.

Low- Pressure boiler installer's examination (class 1B or 2B), you will need to study the following:

- a. The Michigan Boiler Rules – **2013** edition (effective **November 30, 2013**)
- b. The Michigan Boiler Act 290 or 1965 (amended **February 12, 2014**)
- c. ASME Code Section IV, Heating Boilers - **2010** edition with **2011** addenda
- d. ASME Code CSD-1 - **2009** edition

High Pressure boiler installer's examination (class 3B – 5B) you will need to study the following:

- a. The Michigan Boiler Rules – **2013** edition (effective **November 30, 2013**)
- b. The Michigan Boiler Act 290 or 1965 (amended **February 12, 2014**)
- c. ASME Code Section I - **2010** edition with **2011** addenda
- d. ASME Code Section IV - **2010** edition with **2011** addenda
- e. ASME Section IX Welding - **2010** edition with **2011** addenda
- f. ASME B31.1 Power Piping **2010** edition
- g. ASME Code CSD-1 – **2009** edition

Piping examination (license P) you will need to study the following:

- a. The Michigan Boiler Rules – **2013** edition (effective **November 30, 2013**)
- b. The Michigan Boiler Act 290 or 1965 (amended **February 12, 2014**)
- c. ASME B31.1 Power Piping **2010** edition
- d. ASME Section IX Welding - **2010** edition with **2011** addenda

The examinations are Open Book. The examinee is responsible to bring the applicable codebooks to the examination. Highlighting and tabbed pages are the only acceptable changes to the codebooks.

Examinations, offered quarterly: March, June, September, and December.

NOTE: Electronic copies and/or photocopies of the codebooks are NOT allowed during examination.

All applications must be in the Boiler Division office 30 days prior to the examination date.
