Directions to Canton Township Banquet & Conference Center

From the Ann Arbor area:

M-14 east to the Ford Road (EXIT 10). Head east on Ford Road for 17 miles to Canton Center Road. Turn right and head south for ½ mile. Turn right at Summit Parkway. Proceed to third driveway and turn right.

Summit on the Park.

-or-

US-23 to I-94 east to Belleville Road north (EXIT 190). This will turn into Canton Center Road when you cross Michigan Ave. (US-12). Follow north to Summit Parkway. Turn left and proceed to third driveway on right.

Summit on the Park.

From the Port Huron area:

I-94 west to I-696 west to I-275 south to the Ford Road (EXIT 25). Turn right on Ford Road for 3 miles to Canton Center Road. Turn left at traffic light and head south on Canton Center Road to Summit Parkway.

Turn right and proceed to third driveway on right. *Summit on the Park.*

From the Detroit area:

Ford Road (EXIT 25). Turn right on Ford Road for 3 miles to Canton Center Road. Turn left at traffic light and head south on Canton Center Road to Summit Parkway. Turn right and proceed to third driveway on right.

Summit on the Park.

-or-

I-94 west to Belleville Road north (EXIT 190). This will turn into Canton Center Road when you cross Michigan Ave. (US-12). Follow north to Summit Parkway. Turn left and proceed to third driveway on right.

From the Lansing area

I-96 east toward Detroit, to I-275 south, to the Ford Road (EXIT 25). Turn right on Ford Road for 3 miles to Canton Center Road. Turn left at traffic light and head south on Canton Center Road to Summit Parkway.

Turn right and proceed to third driveway on right. *Summit on the Park.*
