From I-496 - From St. Johns, Grand Ledge, Grand Rapids

Take I-496 to Pennsylvania Ave (EXIT 7). Be aware that Cedar Street, Larch Street and Pennsylvania Avenue use the same I-496 exit. Turn south on Pennsylvania Avenue for 1-½ miles. Just past the railroad bridge, turn left at the fourth driveway. Cross street: S. Dexter Drive. Building is identified as Lansing Area Safety Council.

From East or Westbound I-96 - From Detroit, Jackson, Battle Creek

Take I-96 to Pennsylvania Avenue/Cedar Street (EXIT 104). Turn right at first traffic light, Pennsylvania Avenue. Proceed North for approximate 2¼ miles. Just past Gilbert Lumber Company, turn right at the next driveway. Cross street: S. Dexter Drive. Building is identified as Lansing Area Safety Council.
