# Parts 6, 33, & 433 Personal Protective Equipment Standards for General Industry & Construction

## 1 Who Should Attend . . .

This seminar is a must for anyone concerned about health and safety on the job including:

## 2 MIOSHA Training Institute

MIOSHA Consultation Education and Training (CET) Division and Macomb Community College (MCC) have developed the MIOSHA Training Institute (MTI) through a formal alliance. The MTI introduced an Assessment-Based Certificate program, effective October 1, 2007. The certificate program offers participants an opportunity to be recognized for their educational efforts and increased technical expertise. Courses are offered throughout the state in sponsorship with other M-TEC<sup>SM</sup> facilities, community colleges, and safety and health organizations. ## 3 What You'll Learn . . .

This course will provide the participant an overview of MIOSHA personal protective equipment (PPE) requirements contained in MIOSHA General Industry Parts 33 and 433, as well as MIOSHA Construction Part 6, PPE requirements for other MIOSHA standards and MIOSHA's instruction on the Application of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Standards (MIOSHA-STD-08-1) will also be addressed. Methods for conducting and documenting hazard surveys, PPE selection and maintenance criteria, and PPE training requirements are described. Sample PPE photos and scenarios will be included and discussed in the program. Tools for PPE hazard surveys will be provided to assist students in conducting and documenting hazard surveys in the workplace.

#### Participants will be able to:

- ▶ Identify MIOSHA standards and sections addressing personal protective equipment (PPE) in the workplace.
- ▶ Perform and document a simple PPE hazard survey.

- ▶ Identify required PPE training program content and documentation.
