The MTI introduced an Assessment-Based Certificate program, effective October 1, 2007. This course is a MTI Level Two course. The certificate program offers participants an opportunity to be recognized for their educational efforts and increased technical expertise. Courses are offered throughout the state in sponsorship with other M-TECSM facilities, community colleges, and safety and health organizations.
