As of March 31, 2014 this project has logged 148,118 hours.

The Spectrum Health-ICC Beltline Medical Center will be a new 120,000 square foot integrated care campus facility. The center will provide the following services to the Grand Rapids community; urgent care, women's health, primary care, neurosciences, laboratory, rehabilitation and imaging. The building will encompass 4 stories with conventional steel construction with engineered metal stud walls, masonry, metal panels, and glass storefronts. The interior of the facility will be installed on an access floor system with stranded metal stud and drywall construction. Ground breaking has already started for this project and the project is expected to be completed in the spring of 2014.

Innovative Best Practices/Safety Initiatives:

- 100% fall protection over 6 feet, including steel erection and roof work.
- 100% PPE that includes hard hats, eye protection, and appropriate work footwear.
- Mandatory safety orientation; includes project-specific safety video and written test.
- All crane operators will be Certified Crane Operators.
- Mandatory pre-work and post-accident substance abuse testing.
- Pre-Task Analysis' completed and submitted to Elzinga & Volkers, Inc. prior to each shift and prior to the beginning critical work.
- Uniformly enforced disciplinary action plan among all contractors.
