Workplace Safety Makes Good Business Sense

The costs of reacting to workplace injuries and illnesses far exceed the costs of preventing them from happening in the first place.

The **direct costs*** of workplace accidents were estimated at \$62 billion in 2016.

Direct costs of a workplace accident/incident include:

- Payment to workers
- Workers' compensation payments
- Medical expenses
- Costs for legal services

Businesses pay additional for **indirect costs**.

Indirect costs of a workplace accident/incident include:

- Replacement workers
- Damaged property
- Accident investigation
- Corrective action
- Delays/lost productivity
- Low employee morale
- Quality disruptions
- Poor customer/community relations

The financial impact of serious workplace incidents are estimated to be more than \$1 billion per week.
