The Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards is pleased to announce that an application process for 2017 Michigan Justice Training Competitive Grants was approved by the Commission on February 10, 2016. The MCOLES projects that a limited amount of funding will be available for grant awards to eligible applicants to provide critical in-service criminal justice training.

A formal notice will be posted on the MCOLES website in April of 2016 with grant application workshops to be held in May. Further dates and detailed information regarding the workshops will be included with the April announcement.

We look forward to working with you during the application process. Again, I would like to emphasize that while we anticipate that funding will be available, we are limited in the amount of funds that will be available which may impact the number of successful candidates we are able to assist.
