



PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS (TWO POSITIONS)

Oakland Community College is currently accepting applications for two open positions of Public Safety Officer.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Must be certified or certifiable through MCOLES; a citizen of the United States and resident of the State of Michigan for one year; a high school graduate or equivalent; Associate degree preferred; and have passed their 18th birthday. Must have weight proportional to height; at least 20/100 vision corrected to 20/20; normal color vision and depth perception in both eyes, and normal hearing in each ear. Must not have been convicted of a violation of criminal law; driving while under the influence of alcohol or drugs; three moving violations in the 24 months previous to application; and two or more times of reckless driving or once of reckless driving or once of reckless driving accompanied by aggravating circumstances.
