

SECTION 18 EMERGENCY EXEMPTION

For Distribution and Use Only in the State of Michigan

For use in connection with an emergency exemption authorized under the provisions of Section 18 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended.

Effective period: May 22, 2009 through October 31, 2009

Ginseng	Alternaria Blight	2.0	Start applications when disease first threatens and repeat every 7-10 days as needed. Apply with ground equipment and a minimum of 80 gallons of water per acre.	Do not apply more than 9 lbs. active (12 lbs. product) per acre per year. Do not apply within 28 days of harvest.

All agricultural workers/handlers (i.e., mixers, loaders, and applicators) applying mancozeb must wear coveralls over long-sleeved shirt and long pants, chemical-resistant gloves, shoes, and socks. During mixing and loading, a chemical-resistant apron and goggles or a face shield must also be worn. Entry into a treated field prior to a 24-hour re-entry interval is prohibited without the protective equipment listed above.

The Michigan Department of Agriculture shall immediately be informed of any adverse effects or misuse resulting from applications made in connection with this specific exemption.
