Rules and Regulations Governing the Show

Exhibitor must be 6 years of age but not over 21 years of age as of January 1 of current year to participate in any youth animal class. For classes under the Youth Educational or Demonstration categories where premiums apply, exhibitors are limited to youth who are 6 years of age but not over 19 years of age as of January 1 of current year. Date of birth must be on entry form. Open Exhibitor must be 6 years of age unless otherwise stated.

1. Both Exhibitor and current W-9 must be filled out and returned. Copies are acceptable. Mail all entries to Michigan State Fair, Agriculture & Livestock Entry Office, 1120 W. State Fair Ave., Detroit, MI 48203. A fee of \$20.00 and per bird fee must accompany your entry. The exhibitor fee includes a complementary season gate pass.
3. All birds must be owned by the exhibitor at the time of making entries. Any misrepresentation in this regard will disqualify the exhibitor from competition and awards. Open & Youth exhibitors may show a maximum of four birds per class.
4. All birds must be banded. Adult birds may be banded with seamless or open bands. No birds are allowed with mating bands. Young birds must be banded with the proper size and variety with either American or Foreign Bands.
5. Make no substitution other than in the same class. Only one substitution per breed will be permitted until opening day of Fair.
6. Use entry form and pages 4, 5 and 6 to enter.
7. Birds shall not be handled except by the exhibitor, superintendent, his assistants and the judge.
8. Fair management will furnish the pigeons proper care, food, water and grit; however, Fair management will not be responsible for loss or accidents to birds exhibited.
9. The Superintendent will examine all birds upon arrival. Unhealthy or diseased specimens will not be accepted for exhibition.
10. Pigeon judges are not allowed to show any birds in this Department.
11. Birds entered for exhibition may be sold on release day.
12. The Michigan Department of Agriculture Regulation No. 117 provides that pigeons known to be affected with a communicable disease shall not be offered for exhibition nor allowed to mingle with other exhibits on the fairgrounds.
13. If you have not received your premium money by Nov 1 current year contact the entry office, as the fair will honor NO claims after Dec 1.

(American Poultry Assoc. & American Bantam Assoc. age requirements) Date of birth must be on entry form.
Open Exhibitor must be 6 years of age as of January 1 current year, unless otherwise stated.
2. Classes will be conducted according to the rules of the A.P.A. & A.B.A
3. All birds must be owned by the exhibitor. Open & Youth exhibitors may show a maximum of four birds per class.
4. Owners may sell birds at the fair and such birds may be released to the buyer the last day of the Fair, after 4 p.m.
Posting of "for sale" signs for Last Day of fair permitted.
5. State Fair Management will disqualify exhibits which are not worthy of exhibition.

3. Entries on State Fair Exhibitor Entry Form, shall be made at the office of the Poultry Superintendent in the Poultry Building by 11:00 a.m. on the day of the contest. Only two entries are allowed per exhibitor per class. If not entered in other classes in the Poultry Department a \$10.00 entry fee and \$10.00 office fee is required.
4. Qualified judges will be assigned to record the number of crows during the specified time. Ties will be "Crowed Off" by rules set up by the Committee.
5. The rooster with the most crows during a 7-minute period is the winner.
6. Handlers must put the roosters into individual coops and stay at least six feet away from the coop. They may clap, whistle, or talk to the birds.
7. Any live rooster may be entered.
