It is agreed that the applicant has read the current Rules and Regulations, which are incorporated herein by reference and become a part of the contract between the exhibitor and the Michigan State Fair.

Every person who makes an entry at the State Fair herewith exempts and discharges the Michigan Department of Management & Budget, its agents, servants and employees from liability for any loss, damage or injury to himself or his property, weather caused by the said Department, its agents, servants or employees, or by any other cause. Every exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned by any animals owned or exhibited by him or arising from acts or negligence of any servant or employee of such exhibitor.

The Manager or his designated representatives reserves the right to inspect all vehicles upon leaving the Fairgrounds

ALL ANIMAL EXHIBITOR AGREEMENT:

I certify that all my animal projects are drug free by Federal Food and Drug Administration standards. I have followed all withdraw periods for animal health products and substances used, practiced good animal husbandry, and my project has been ethically and humanely cared for. I acknowledge and accept the fact that my animals may be subject to drug and residue testing. Upon a positive confirmation forfeiture of all prize money, sale and/or market value, premiums and trophies will be the penalty. My parents or guardians assume equal responsibility for following these and other prescribed guidelines set by the fair for these projects.

General Agreement

I (We) agree that Canine Combustion Dog Agility Club, Inc. has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the organizing committee alone shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, of the holding of the event and of the opportunity to have the dog participate and/or to be judged, I (we) agree to hold the organizing committee, Canine Combustion Dog Agility Club, Inc., United States Dog Agility Association, Inc., including their members, officers, directors, agents and employees, sponsors of the event and owners of the premises upon which the event is held and their employees harmless from any claim for loss or injury that may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premised or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim. I (We) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, appearance, theft, damage or injury, be cause or alleged to be caused by the negligence of parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. Further, I (we) represent that I (we) am (are) the owner of the dog aforementioned, or that I (we) have full authority as agent for dog's owner and shall hold Canine Combustion Dog Agility Club, Inc., USDAA, including their officers, directors, employees and agents and their sponsors harmless from any liability or claims make by dog's owner.
