**Notice of Drainage Board Meeting
for the Determination of Abandonment
of Drain or Portion Thereof**

(In accordance with P.A. 40, of 1956, as amended, M.C.L. 280.391)

DINGMAN INTERCOUNTY DRAIN

Notice is hereby given, that on April 15, 2015, a petition was filed with the Midland County Drain Commissioner, praying for the abandonment and vacation of the upper portion of a drain known and designated as the Dingman Intercounty Drain; and

Whereas, the Drainage District for the Dingman Intercounty Drain includes lands within the following counties and their respective municipalities: Midland County: Midland Township and the City of Midland; and Bay County: Williams Township; and

Whereas, due notice of the filing of said petition and copy thereof was served upon Joseph Rivet, Bay County Drain Commissioner; and Jamie Clover Adams, Director of the Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development; by Doug Enos, Midland County Drain Commissioner;

Now therefore, in accordance with P.A. 40, of 1956, as amended, **a Drainage Board meeting of the Dingman Intercounty Drain will be held on July 30, 2015, at 10:00 a.m. at the Midland County Commissioner's Chambers, 220 West Ellsworth Street, Midland, in the county of Midland**, to hear objections to the abandonment of the portion of the Dingman Drain described as commencing at the upper terminus of the drain located at a point on the North 1/8 line of Section 2, Town 14 North and Range 2 West, Midland Township, Midland County, said point being 799 feet East of the North-South 1/4 Line of said Section 2 of Midland Township, thence running downstream as follows: South 660 feet, more or less, to the north right-of-way line of Diamond Drive, also being the lower terminus of the proposed abandoned section of drain; and to determine if the abandonment of this portion of the Dingman Intercounty Drain can be accomplished without interfering with or in any way impairing the private rights of any persons acquired by reason of the establishment and construction of said drain or part thereof.

Now therefore, all persons owning lands liable to an assessment for benefits, or whose private rights acquired by reason of the establishment and construction of said drain may be impaired or interfered with, or any municipality affected, are requested to be present at said meeting, if they so desire. Public comment will be received at the meeting. Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation

in the meeting should contact the Drain Commissioner in the county which they reside at the numbers noted below (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 711 (TDD) at least one week in advance of the meeting to request mobility, visual, hearing, or other assistance.
