MICHIGAN PESTICIDE REGISTRATION FEES HAVE CHANGED FOR 2016

RE: Michigan Pesticide Registration Fee Changes

Dear Pesticide Registrant:

On October 1, 2015, amendments to Act 451, Part 83, Pesticide Control took effect, increasing pesticide registration fees and changing the way water quality protection fees (previously called groundwater protection fees) are assessed. The following changes will be made for the collection of pesticide registration fees and water quality protection fees for the registration cycle beginning July 1, 2016 and ending June 30, 2017.

Pesticide Fee Changes

2016 Fees	Product Type	Fee per Product
Registration Fee	All	\$100
Water Quality Protection Fee	All	\$270
Total Fees per Product		\$370

The new fee structure will take effect on **April 1, 2016**. Any registrant that submits a pesticide registration postmarked after April 1st will need to pay the new fees (\$370/product). For registrants that currently have products registered in Michigan, your 2016/2017 renewal packages will be mailed out in mid-April and the new fees will apply to all products being renewed.
