Dear Ms. Canfora:

Pursuant to the requirements of the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (the "WARN Act"), this letter is being provided to notify you of the anticipated reduction in force at AEES, Inc. ("AEES" or "Company")'s EPC Mattawan facility located at 53150 N. Main, Mattawan, Michigan 49071. By providing this notice, the Company does not concede or admit that the WARN Act applies or that notice is otherwise required. We expect the reduction in force to commence on or about August 3, 2010, and to be completed by on or about August 17, 2010.

This is anticipated to be a permanent layoff of the affected employees and involves the closing of the EPC Mattawan operating unit. A total of approximately 4 employees are anticipated to be separated from their employment with the Company at this time. The anticipated layoff schedule is as follows:
