Bolton Conductive Systems plans to permanently terminate the employment of all employees at its Walled Lake facility located at 1164 Ladd Road, Walled Lake, Michigan. These terminations are in conjunction with the permanent and complete closing of this manufacturing facility scheduled for July 1, 2013.

The scheduled timing for the first permanent employment terminations is set for on or about April 22, 2013. In adhering to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (WARN), employees will receive written notice of the date of their termination of employment at least sixty days in advance of their termination of employment. At that time I will send you the termination schedule along with job titles and the number of employees holding those job titles. As of today, a total of approximately 65 employment terminations are expected.

There is no labor organization representing the affected employees. The affected employees have no bumping rights.
