Re: Carron Industries/WARN Act Loss of Employment


Dear Mr. Houck:

This letter is sent as notice in compliance with this company's obligation under the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (WARN), 29 USC Sec. 2101 et seq. to notify the State of Michigan concerning a loss of employment at our facilities in Inkster, Michigan. The address of our Inkster office is 26700 Princeton Ave, 48141.

More particularly Carron Industries has made a final business decision to permanently terminate the Ford Garage Service Light Truck Operation at its Inkster, Michigan facilities, effective on or about September 25, 2001. It is presently anticipated that the termination will result in the loss of approximately 178 hourly jobs and 16 salaried positions as of that date.
