**WORKFORCE TRANSITION**

Dear Mr. Houck:

This notice is being provided pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification (“WARN”) Act.

Assembly Test & Technology (“ATT”) currently operates facilities located at 12841 Stark Rd. Livonia, MI 48150 and 400 Florence St. Saginaw, MI 48602-1298. DT Industries, Inc. (“DT Industries” or the “Company”), ATT’s parent corporation, has reached an agreement regarding the sale of ATT and believes it is likely that a sale of ATT will occur. Although an exact date is not yet known, the Company presently expects that such a sale will be completed within the next 60 days. Although the Company does not know what employment decisions will be made by the purchaser, at such time operations at the Livonia and Saginaw facilities may permanently close or experience a mass layoff. If the plant closing or mass layoff occurs, the Company anticipates that up to 123 (74 Livonia; 49 Saginaw) employees would be permanently terminated. A list of the potentially affected employees, including each employee’s job title, is attached. The employees would not have any bumping rights.
