Students are trained in the operation of state-of-the-art CNC panel processing equipment, spindle moulders, profile grinders, and numerous other woodworking machines. Students work on individual as well as production projects. Strong industry involvement helps ensure students have marketable skills upon graduation. Flexible training options provide students with an opportunity to develop individual skills depending on interest and ability.

Job Outlook

Starting wages vary according to geographic region and area of specialty. However, program graduates typically are offered starting wages 25 to 30 percent higher than average.
