This letter is to notify you that due to the United States Department of Transportation / Transportation Security Administration's (TSA) takeover of our security/passenger screening operations at Detroit Metropolitan Airport, Detroit, MI, Huntleigh USA Corporation will be closing its airport security operations at Detroit Metropolitan Airport on or by November 18, 2002.
