Dear Sir/Madam:

This letter shall constitute notice under the federal Worker Adjustment And Retraining Notification (WARN) Act that a *mass layoff* as defined in the Act is anticipated at the Lear Corporation – Romulus II facility located at 36310 Eureka Road, Romulus, Michigan. The exact date or dates the layoffs will occur is not entirely certain as the customer schedules dictate production requirements, and the transfer of the work can be accomplished, are controlling the timing issues. The best information the company has available at this time is that the layoffs will occur in late in July 2001 and impact approximately 75% of the workforce. The bargaining representative for the hourly employees is UAW Local 174, located at 6494 West Warren Ave. Detroit, MI 48210, President Jim Baker. We have provided the union with a current seniority list of the hourly employees, a copy of which is enclosed. These employees have bumping rights and, as a result, we do not know at this time the names of the affected employees who will be ultimately displaced and suffer an employment loss.

The entire plant is not being closed and Lear Corporation is hopeful about the prospect that some or all of the employees can be recalled or placed elsewhere in the future. Should circumstances change, however, please be advised that there is a ~~pro~~vision in our labor agreement that gives employees, in the event of a *plant lay off* (as defined by the contract), the opportunity to preferential hiring treatment in our Romulus I Facility. We will work diligently with the UAW to minimize the impact on employees.
