Dear Ms. Hennessey:

This letter is an update to my letter of October 5, 2006. In that letter we advised you that Lear Corporation has developed plans to reduce its workforce at its facility located at 23750 Regency Park Drive, Warren, MI 48089, that consistent with these plans, employment separations are expected to begin on or about December 4, 2006, and that we anticipate these employment separations to be permanent.

At this time, the Company continues to anticipate that a group of affected employees will be laid off during a 14-day period commencing on December 4, 2006. However, as a result of the Company's inability to secure work which it anticipated receiving from Daimler Chrysler, the Company now anticipates that an additional group of affected employees will be laid off during the 14-day period commencing on December 4, 2006. We were unable to provide you with any earlier notification of the December 4, 2006 layoffs because the Company just learned that it was not awarded the work from Daimler Chrysler, and this decision was not previously foreseeable. A revised list of job titles and the number of employees currently holding affected positions accompanies this letter as Attachment A.


The above dates are based on the best information currently available, although it remains possible that other considerations might affect the timing of employment separations. You will be notified if there is any further change in this timetable.

The United Automobile Workers represents some of the employees who will be affected by the Company's plans, which have been described in separate letters forwarded to Mike Michniak, President, UAW Local 771, located at 1640 Stephenson Highway, Troy, MI 48083. Any bumping rights for affected union-represented employees would be governed by union agreements.
