
This letter is to inform you that the undersigned represents Leaseway Multi Transportation Services, Inc. (LMTSI). This letter constitutes written notice to you pursuant to the notice requirements of the WARN Act legislation. LMTSI maintains a rail loading facility at 1750 Brown Road, Auburn Hills, Michigan.*

At present, LMTSI employs approximately 37 individuals at its Auburn Hills terminal. The yardmen employed by LMTSI are represented for purposes of collective bargaining by the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local Union 614. The Teamster Agent who represents the LMTSI employees is Mr. Earl Walker.

Due to an unfavorable economic position, LMTSI will close its Auburn Hills Terminal effective with the close of business on December 31, 2001. That cancellation will result in the permanent layoff of all of the individuals identified on the attached Exhibit.

We deeply regret having to provide you with this notification, however, due to the adverse economic position of the Auburn Hills operation, LMTSI has no alternative. If you should have any questions regarding this matter, do not hesitate to call me.
