Dear Ms. Hennessey:

Please be advised that Motor City Central Parking will be laying off employees at both the McNamara and Smith/Berry Terminals of the Detroit Metropolitan Airport. These layoffs will be permanent. It is anticipated that the layoffs will occur in three phases as follows: during a 14-day period beginning on June 27, 2005; a 14-day period beginning on September 28, 2005 and a 14 day period beginning on November 29, 2005. Ninety Four (94) Employees holding the job classification of Cashier, 64; LPI, 20; Technicians, 3; Money Counters, 4; and 3 Auditors will be affected by the layoffs.

These layoffs and any bumping rights which might exist will be implemented pursuant to the provisions of a Collective Bargaining Agreement between Motor City Central Parking and the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 283. Mr. Steve Hicks and Mr. Michael Finnegan are Union officials who represent Local 283. The Local's address is 1625 Fort Street, Wyandotte, MI 48192. Motor City Central Parking is currently in contract negotiations with the Federation of Private Employees and Mr. Guy Masters is the Union official who represents this Union. The address is 1700 N.W. 66th Avenue, Suite 100-C, Plantation, FL 33313.



Dear Ms. Hennessey:

By letter dated April 22, 2005, I advised you that Motor City Central Parking would be laying off employees at the McNamara and Smith / Berry Terminals of the Detroit Metropolitan Airport. I further advised you that we expected these layoffs to occur in June 2005, that the layoffs would affect employees in the job classifications of cashiers and LPI, and that laid off employees would be afforded any bumping rights which might exist under the Collective Bargaining Agreement between Motor City Central Parking and the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 283. These layoffs have been postponed due to a delay in the installation of revenue control equipment, which is owned and controlled by the Wayne County Metropolitan Authority. Accordingly, the layoffs previously announced to you will now occur during the 14-day period beginning August 25, 2005.
