

You should also be made aware that due to some attrition and our ability to place employees in other positions, the closing only affected a total of forty-four (44) employees rather than the seventy-four (74) originally reported.


To Whom It May Concern:

This letter will serve as notification that we are amending the original WARN notification dated April 6, 2001. Our customer has advised us that our business contract will expire on May 21, 2001 rather than between June 4 and July 6, 2001 as originally communicated. This is an unexpected business loss and we have made our employees aware of this change.

The total number of employees affected by this unexpected business loss will be a maximum of forty-three employees. This number is a reduction from the original number of seventy-four reported in our previous communication. This change is due to employment offers from other Ryder operations, work offers from the company taking over the business Ryder now services, and voluntary quits.
