



The Michigan Energy Office (MEO) is finalizing the recipient selection for the 2011 Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) Advanced Lighting Technology Demonstration Grant. The purpose of the grant is to encourage local governments to showcase higher efficiency lighting technologies and applications, such as Light Emitting Diodes (LEDs), Induction, and High Efficiency Plasma in their communities. Another goal is to increase awareness of the growing supply chain for advanced lighting technology in Michigan. Ultimately, each grant recipient will make their own decision as to which manufacturer/supplier to contract with for their project. However, to make the search easier, we are developing a directory of companies that make, assemble, distribute, design strategies for use, and install the grant eligible lighting systems for Michigan.

This directory will be posted on the MEO website (www.michigan.gov/energyoffice) on July 14th in advance of the announcement of grant awards. To be included in the first edition, we ask that you complete the survey by July 12th. However, we plan to update the directory periodically as new submissions are received.
