CLAC and Performance Metrics (PM)

- Performance Metric subcommittee formed Fall 2013
- Reviewed and updated MPRs for the next Accreditation Cycle
- Developing LHD Performance Metrics Scorecard
- Focus on Outcomes which tell our ‘story’

Comprehensive CSHCS Assessment

- Assess CSHCS Operations in light of system changes and opportunities.
- Understand the impact of these changes
- 4 components
 - Division Staff
 - Local Health Departments
 - Families
 - Data

Comprehensive CSHCS Assessment

- How should CSHCS Division organize the work to better meet the needs of our customers?
- Customers include
 - CYSHCN
 - Families
 - Local Health Departments
 - Medical Providers, Hospitals, Health Plans, etc

Managed Care

- Medicaid Managed Care and CYSHCN
 - While the transition is complete, the work is not
 - AMCHP Action Learning Collaborative
 - Standards for Systems of Care for Children and Youth with Special Health Care Needs
 - Care Coordination and Care Planning
 - CSHCS Stakeholder Group
 - Subcommittee of CAC
- MIChild transition

- Affordable Care Act and CSHCS
 - Approximately 8% of CSHCS enrollees without health insurance
 - Correspondence sent to families without other insurance
 - Led to more discussions with TPL
 - Underinsured work screen

Healthy Michigan Plan

- Presentation at March MCH Workgroup
- www.michigan.gov/healthymichiganplan
- 139,774 enrollees as of 4/21/14
- CSHCS implications
 - CSHCS/HMP duals excluded from health plan enrollment
 - Approximately 600 adult CSHCS enrollees, age 19+, could be eligible for HMP
 - TEP

CMS Clinics

- Children's Multi-Disciplinary Specialty Clinics
- Site reviews
- Program reporting and expectations
- Billing challenges
- Coordination/communication with MHPs and LHDs

CAHPS

- Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems
- CSHCS CAHPS conducted every other year
- 2014 will include FFS and MHP sample
- Health Plan specific findings
- Questions on LHDs and Family Center
- Report due in November 2014

CYSHCN vs. CSHCS

- How should we assist and support families with a child with a special need that is not medically eligible for CSHCS?
- Title V expectation
- Co-morbidities
- Behavioral Health
- Care Coordination
