Policy Summary: Family Planning Clinics are being notified of 11 Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes they may begin to bill with the appropriate Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA) certification on and after February 1, 2011.

Purpose: To improve the reproductive health of the women in Michigan by increasing the number of laboratory services that can be provided by Family Planning Clinics.

Programs Affected: Medicaid, Plan First!

Effective for dates of service on and after February 1, 2011, family planning clinics can bill the following 11 Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes as identified in Table 1. In order to bill for these codes, family planning clinics must have the appropriate Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA) certification.
