

STATUS OF THE RATE DEVELOPMENT AND NUMBER OF DUAL ELIGIBLES ENROLLED BY MONTH IN MEDICAID HEALTH PLANS

(FY2011 Appropriation Bill - Public Act 187 of 2010)

November 30, 2011

Section 1783: (1) The department shall develop rates by April 1 of the current fiscal year for the enrollment of individuals dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid into Medicaid health plans if those health plans also maintain a Medicare advantage special needs plan certified by the centers for Medicare and Medicaid services. (2) The department shall report quarterly to the house and senate appropriations subcommittees on community health and to the house and senate fiscal agencies the status of the rate development described in subsection (1) and the number of dual eligibles enrolled by month in Medicaid health plans with Medicare advantage special needs plan certification for the current fiscal year.

FY2011 Boilerplate Report - Section 1783(2)

This section requires that the department shall report quarterly on the status of rate development for rates for the enrollment of individuals dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid into Medicaid Health Plans if these plans also maintain a Medicare advantage special needs plan certified by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

Due to technical difficulties, implementation of optional enrollment for persons dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid into all Medicaid health plans was delayed until November 1, 2011.

Capitation Rates were developed and loaded into the Community Health Automated Medicaid Processing System (CHAMPS) so that payments could be made to all plans starting that month. 3,325 were enrolled during the month of November, 2011.
