Blood Lead Testing Methodology

- **Children must have been eligible for one of the following programs in August 2010**
 - Medicaid Managed Care (MC)
 - enrolled in a Medicaid Health Plan (MHP)
 - Medicaid Fee-for-Service (FFS)
 - enrolled for Medicaid Only FFS coverage
 - Medicaid and CSHCS Dual Eligible (Duals)
 - dually eligible for both Medicaid and CSHCS
- **Blood Lead testing results include children tested:**
 - on or before indicated birthday for 2 and 3 year olds
 - at any time between ages 1 to 6
- **Unique Client Identifier (UCI) used to establish link between Medicaid and lead databases.**

Blood Lead Testing Summary


- **2 year old children tested on or before their 2nd birthday**

- 68% Statewide
- 70% City of Detroit
- 69% Statewide for Medicaid MC
 - 76% Statewide for Medicaid MC with 12-Month Continuous Enrollment
- 60% Statewide for Medicaid Only FFS Eligibles
- 70% Statewide for CSHCS Duals


- **3 year old children tested on or before their 3rd birthday**

- 73% Statewide
- 81% City of Detroit
- 74% Statewide for Medicaid MC
 - 81% Statewide for Medicaid MC with 12-Month Continuous Enrollment
- 67% Statewide for Medicaid Only FFS Eligibles
- 73% Statewide for CSHCS Duals

-Enrolled in same health plan for the measurement month and 12 months preceding 2nd birthday, with a 1-month allowable gap.




- Enrolled in plan (health plan or FFS) for the measurement month

Continuous Enrollment

- Based on MMIS eligibility system
- Enrolled in same plan (health plan or FFS) for the measurement month and 12 months preceding 3rd birthday, with 1-month allowable gap
