## Goal of Access Services:

To improve access for Michigan citizens to substance abuse treatment services, to provide initial screenings, and to arrange for placement in services appropriate to the individual needs of clients.

## Services:

Throughout Michigan, Substance Abuse Regional Coordinating Agencies (CAs) maintain an access system to:

1. *Provide a point of entry to substance abuse treatment services*
2. *Provide an initial screening to determine alcohol and other drug treatment needs and eligibility*
3. *Determine financial eligibility*
4. *Refer to substance abuse treatment*
5. *Refer to other support services*
6. *Provide case management services for priority populations*

These services are available to all individuals in a community. Individuals in need of state-funded treatment services must have the services authorized by the local CA before entering treatment.

The order of preference for admission to substance abuse treatment is given to:

- *Pregnant injecting drug users*
- *Pregnant substance abusers*
- *Injecting drug users*
- *Parents whose children have been, or are in danger of being, removed from the home under Michigan child protection laws because of the parent's substance abuse.*
- *All other individuals*

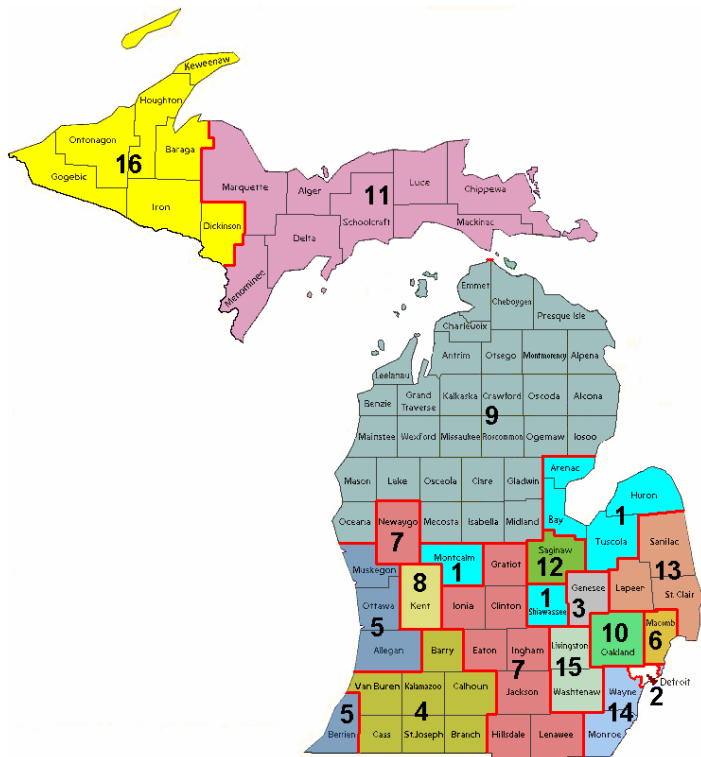
