### Calculating Adjusted Age

Determine the number of weeks the child was premature, based upon an expected gestation of 40 weeks.  
For example: a child born at 28 weeks is 12 weeks premature (40-28 = 12).

To calculate the child's adjusted age subtract the number of weeks premature from the from the child's chronological age.

Example:

### Chronological Age

Zach was born at 28 weeks on February 27, 2009. Today's date is 3/16/10. His chronological age is 1 year and 19 days or 12 months and 19 days.

Month	Day	Year
3	16	10
- 2	27	09

(Take 30 days from the month column to give to days column to subtract. 16 + 30 = 46).
