    - Similar to EVS, WebDenis and Netwerkes

    - Claim status
    - Direct data entry
    - On-line claim correction
  - Prior Authorization
    - On-line entry
    - On-line corrections
    - On-line status



# PE Subsystem Current vs. New

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- Legacy ID Driven
- Paper submission
- Manual License Checks
- Multiple Address Combinations
- Paper Signature
- No Group Enrollment
- 4-6 weeks
- NPI Driven
- On-line submission
- Automatic License validation
- Address Standardization
- Electronic Signature
- Group Enrollment
- 1 week after Revalidation



# Importance of Revalidation

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- Outdated provider information
- Ability for MDCH to gather additional information
- Continue to receive payments once CHAMPS “goes live”
- New enrollment required after 7-31-2008
- Current PE information will be converted into CHAMPS and pre-populated for validation
- Make sure information for requirements are gathered prior to Revalidation



# CHAMPS Associations

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- Billing Provider associates to a Billing Agent
- Rendering Provider associates to a Billing Provider
- Types of Billing Providers:
  - Medical and Dental Groups
  - Clinics
    - Family Planning
    - Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC)
    - Rural Health Center
    - Tribal Health Center
    - Local Health Department



# SSO and Domain

- Single Sign-On (SSO)
  - All users must have their own user ID and password to access CHAMPS
  - MDCH encourages each organization to keep a list of all user IDs
- Domains
  - Security levels set-up to allow users different levels of access to information within CHAMPS
  - Assignment of security levels for users



# Tracking Number

- Provider Application Notification Number
  - 14 digit number required to access provider information
    - Only used for revalidation
    - Once your application is approved your NPI will be used to access your provider file
  - One number issued per SSN/NPI or Tax ID/NPI combination
  - Mailed approximately 2 weeks prior to February 1, 2008
    - Mailing will be on green paper
