



CHAMPS Enhancement to User List Page

Effective January 25, 2010 an enhancement was implemented to update the User List Page in CHAMPS. Previously, when Domain Administrators would first access the User List page, the users for the domain would automatically be listed on the screen. Now when the User List page is accessed, the page will initially come up blank and show **“No Records Found!”**
