Re: CPR certifications
Date: January 8, 2014

As a licensed EMS provider in the state of Michigan, you must have a valid CPR card at the Healthcare Provider or Professional Rescuer level to maintain your license.

Effective January 1, 2014, our office will only recognize the American Heart Association Healthcare Provider or the American Red Cross Professional Rescuer cards. These cards will still be eligible for 1 medical practical credit on renewal.

If a healthcare provider CPR card is submitted on audit from a different source, it will be considered on a case by case basis through December 31, 2014.

No on-line CPR cards will be approved by our office for initial or renewal of CPR.
