Nominations will only be accepted from agencies whose rights systems are in substantial compliance with the ORR standards.

In order to be considered for this award, a rights program must have developed a program or process that has a direct impact on the ability of consumers to advocate for themselves in the protection of their rights.

The Director's Award for Advocacy on Behalf of Mental Health Recipients

In order to be considered for this award, a rights program must make an outstanding contribution toward advocating on behalf of the recipients it serves.

The Director's Award for Innovation in Recipient Rights Protection

In order to be considered for this award, a rights program must have developed an innovative way of including consumers in the rights protection process.
