

BONE MARROW TRANSPLANTATION (BMT) SERVICES

STANDARD ADVISORY COMMITTEE (SAC) CHARGE

**Approved by the Certificate of Need (CON) Commission Vice-Chairperson
as Delegated by the CON Commission and Commission Chairperson on
March 26, 2009 and Revised April 20, 2009**

The BMT Transplantation Services SAC is charged to review and recommend any necessary changes to the BMT Services Standards (along with its rationale for maintaining or changing each key provision) regarding the following:

1. Consider and recommend whether continued regulation of these services is necessary.
2. Look at statewide access issues, with particular reference to access outside southeast Michigan.

The SAC is to promptly report back to the Commission on the first two charges.

Depending upon its report, the SAC would then look at the issues of need, access, cost, quality, and the possibility of a consortium approach for BMT services.

In addition, the SAC shall consider possible changes in the planning area(s), comparative review criteria, and whether the need methodology should be facility-specific or determination of the appropriate maximum number of BMT programs in the planning area(s).
