



## DATABASE INSTRUCTIONS

### Private Duty Nursing (PDN) Reimbursement

This document contains information for interpreting this Michigan Medicaid database. Providers are instructed to refer to the Michigan Medicaid Provider Manual and/or MSA Bulletins for specific coverage, reimbursement policies, and required forms. Data elements and descriptions for this database are as follows:

Data Element	Description
HCPCS Code	The HCPCS Level II code used to denote a service.
Short Description	The short description of the service associated with the HCPCS code.
Provider Type	Denotes a licensed RN or LPN enrolled in Medicaid as an individual or part of a Private Duty Nursing (PDN) agency.
Modifier	Reported modifier identifies a set fee screen as follows: TD = Service is provided by a Licensed Registered Nurse (RN) TE = Service is provided by a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)
Modifier – Additional Patient(s)	Reported modifier identifies a set fee screen as follows: TT = Additional patient(s) (Report TT modifier with TD or TE when applicable.)
Revenue Code	A revenue code is required for billing purposes along with the procedure code when services are provided by a PDN agency.
Rate	The rate is based on a 15-minute unit.
