**II. Summary of 2006 Enterovirus Season**

To date in 2006, the Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) Bureau of Laboratories reported fewer enteroviruses than in 2005. This continues the downward trend of specimens submitted for enterovirus culture, from 79 year to date in 2003 to 21 in 2006. Of those 21 samples received this year, the lab was able to isolate an enterovirus in 4. The age distribution on these 4 confirmed cases was from 5 days old to 34 years. **III. Summary of Enterovirus Data by Geographic Location**

The data shown here are the results obtained by the MDCH Viral Isolation Laboratory from submitted isolates plus enterovirus isolates recovered from clinical specimens submitted by agencies or physicians in

the state.

To date this season, the MDCH lab received 19 specimens for enterovirus isolation/typing, some of which grew no virus.
