

The Michigan Tuberculosis Nursing Certification Course

This course is intended for local public health communicable disease nurses. The purpose of this course is to provide a Tuberculosis Nursing Certification Course that will serve as a model to the State of Michigan and other state tuberculosis control programs that recognize and acknowledge the expertise and education needed by clinical and field nurses that practice tuberculosis control efforts at the local level. Class is limited to 50 people.

- Must show proof of *current* trainer status for the Michigan TB Skin Testing course
- Must be an RN and provide copy of nursing license

Certification is valid for 2 years, then recertification is achieved by testing
