

Adding Data to ImageTrend



Data may be entered into the state trauma registry, hosted by ImageTrend, in two ways:

1.) Downloading your facility data from the National Trauma Data Bank and importing the file into ImageTrend

2.) Entering your data directly into ImageTrend by direct data entry.

Data Import:

- 1.) To import data into ImageTrend you need access to ImageTrend with a username and password (see *Requesting Image Trend Access* www.michigan.gov/traumasystem).
- 2.) Access ImageTrend website <https://www.mi-emsis.org/patientregistry/>
- 3.) Make sure your NTDB facility ID number is added to the facility information in ImageTrend so the data file is stored properly.
- 4.) For detailed instructions on NTDB data import, access ImageTrend University. You must be logged into ImageTrend and click the "Help" link.
