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MDHHS Bureau of Laboratories
Required Billing Information – ICD-10 Compliance Notification

In order to achieve Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) compliance, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Bureau of Laboratories (MDHHS BOL) requires health care providers use ICD-10 diagnosis codes for *Chlamydia trachomatis* (CT), *Neisseria gonorrhoeae* (GC), and *blood lead* laboratory test orders collected on or after October 1, 2015.

The MDHHS BOL will continue to bill Medicaid and private insurance for this testing performed in our laboratory. The following information is required for billing purposes:

- Ordering Physician Name
- Ordering Physician NPI Number
- ICD-10 code (diagnosis code)
- Medicaid/MCO Number
- For private insurance, complete all fields under PRIVATE INSURANCE INFORMATION on the requisition form

To help collect this information, the MDHHS BOL will continue to fax your agency a line listing of all specimens received missing this critical information. Please complete the fields with missing information and fax it back to the number provided on the fax within one week. Failure to do so will result in your agency receiving an invoice from the MDHHS BOL billing agency, Public Consulting Group (PCG).
