Dear Nursing Facility Administrator and Billing Office:

**Medicare Advantage Plan Co-Insurance Days - Medicaid Overpayments**

As you may be aware, Medicaid has been overpaying particular nursing facility claims that involve Medicare Advantage Plan Co-Insurance Days. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused you. Medicaid Policy Bulletin MSA 09-26 (Issued June 1, 2009) will prevent future overpayments as claims will suspend for manual review if co-insurance days are billed and the beneficiary has Medicare Advantage Plan (Part C) coverage. Please note that the effective date of this bulletin will coincide with the implementation of the Community Health Automated Medicaid Processing System (CHAMPS).

Medicaid overpayments received prior to the implementation of CHAMPS, must be returned to the Michigan Department of Community Health. Nursing facilities must return the overpayments via a check payable to the State of Michigan. The check must include the facility's EIN (tax) number. The check must be mailed to: MDCH/Cashier's Unit, PO Box 30437, Lansing, Michigan 48909. Accompanying the check must be a note explaining the overpayment and copy of the Remittance Advice showing the overpayment. Please indicate on the Remittance Advice the specific beneficiary(ies) that the overpayment is being returned on.
