The purpose of this bulletin is to notify you of the Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) code changes that will be implemented by the Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH). Please note that this notice is distributed to a broad range of providers and not all codes listed may apply to your scope of practice.

Listed below are the new HCPCS procedure codes adopted by MDCH for various provider groups listed above. Any new procedure code not listed will not be covered at this time. The following coding information is based on the most recent file from the Centers of Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).
