Subject: MA Eligibility

Effective: August 1, 2009

Programs Affected: Social Security Income (SSI) related MA

There will no longer be a 90 day limit for a Medicaid applicant to submit Social Security Administration (SSA) approval of Retirement, Survivors and Disability Income (RSDI) based on disability (also known as Social Security Disability) after a State Medical Review Team (MRT) denial of their Medicaid (MA) application. It will allow a previously denied MRT disability application to be re-evaluated by the State without submission of a new application when SSA approves RSDI based on disability.

Manual Maintenance
