**NOTE: Implementation of this policy is contingent upon State Plan Amendment and Waiver approval from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).**

The Graduate Medical Education (GME) Innovations Grants provide support for innovative GME programs that emphasize the importance of coordinated care, health promotions and psychiatric care in integrated systems. The purpose of this training is to develop the skills and experience necessary to provide psychiatric services utilized by Michigan Medicaid patient groups.

The Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) is increasing the GME Innovations Grant to include \$2.8 million for Pine Rest Mental Health Services. This change is effective July 1, 2014.
