
■ Back or neck problem	18.0%
■ Arthritis/rheumatism	12.6%
■ Lung/breathing problem	7.1%
■ Fractures/bone or joint injury	6.5%
■ Walking problem	6.0%
■ Legs, ankle or foot problems/surgery	4.1%
■ Depression, anxiety, emotional problems	3.5%
■ Heart problem	2.9%
■ Knee replacement/artificial knees	2.5%
■ Other knee problems/surgery	2.2%


■ Back or neck problem	13.8%

## *Numbers (in Thousands) With Disabilities By Year, Michigan Adults, 2001 - 2009*




