TOPIC SUMMARIES

I. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS – *Deborah Hollis*

Deborah welcomed the Transformation Steering Committee (TSC). Everyone introduced themselves.

II. REVIEW AGENDA AND MINUTES

No agenda additions. Minutes from the May 15, 2015 meeting were reviewed and approved.

III. BHDDA UPDATES

- **SUD/COD Conference – *Angela Smith-Butterwick***

Angie provided information about the upcoming Substance Use Disorder/Co-occurring Conference to be held September 20-22, 2015 at DeVos Conference Center in Grand Rapids, Michigan. For more information, please visit www.MACMHB.org.

- **Recovery Housing TA – *Angela Smith-Butterwick***

Angela and Deborah announced that Recovery Housing Technical Advisory #11 (TA#11) is ready for the contract negotiation process. Deborah and Angela also briefly explained various areas and answered questions about the draft Recovery Housing TA#11, which included discussion about the National Association of Recovery Residences (NARR). Nancy and Denise will receive a draft copy by e-mail.

- **Training – *Angela Smith-Butterwick***

More than 400 survey responses were received for the Training Survey. As a result, we are planning six evidence-based program prevention trainings and three evidence-based program treatment trainings in 2015. Other trainings will include skill building, and new and emerging practices, including Trauma, Recipient Rights,

and Communicable Disease, among others. These trainings will be available through the Michigan Association of Community Mental Health Boards by visiting www.MACMHB.org. - **Recovery Coach Curriculum – Deborah Hollis for Pam Werner**
The *Recovery Coach Curriculum and Credentialing Committee* will be meeting on August 31 and September 1. Progress is being made on the recommendations from the three groups formed to address criteria of trainers, individuals referred for certification and the Michigan curriculum. All groups have made substantial progress and continue to build on what has been developed. We expect that recommendations from the committee will be finalized by the fall and submitted to MDHHS.
- **Center for the Application of Prevention Technologies (CAPT) Webinars – Larry Scott**
Larry will be sending web-based training opportunities to the TSC from CAPT, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), Stop Act, as well as others as we receive them. You are encouraged to participate and take advantage of these trainings. These trainings are open to all providers who are recipients of Block Grant funding.
- **Other**
 - **Contract negotiations** are underway with the PIHPs and CMHPs.
 - **A workforce survey** has been contracted through Health Management Associates (HMA), to assess our current workforce capacity for prevention and treatment services. This will help us understand our workforce capacity needs now that Healthy Michigan and restructuring is in place.
 - **Trauma Specific training** will be held at the end of July and the first week in August, as well as September.
 - **Certified Community Behavioral Health Centers (CCBHC)** – This is a SAMHSA initiative funded through the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) for 25 states to apply for a planning grant, i.e., health clinics that focus on behavioral health, integration into primary care. The application is due August 5, 2015. Funding will be a one-time amount up to \$2M. Recipients of the planning grant will establish and implement a process of certifying clinics and establishing a prospective payment and evaluation process. Our goal is to be one of the 25 states to receive the planning grant. If we receive the planning grant, the next step will be to create a strategy for completing an application for a demonstration grant, which will give the certifying clinic operation funding for two years. OROSC made sure that SUD, Treatment and Recovery based services are an integral part of this application.
- **Action items from May 21 meeting**
 - **PA2 Funding Decrease Strategy (List items funded and not funded).**
The SAPT Directors will discuss the decrease in PA2 funding and its impact. The question needs to be answered as to whether Block Grant funds can be for services formally funded with PA2 funds.

IV. Discussion on ROSC Transformation – Lisa Miller/All

Lisa presented to the group the concept of merging mental health recovery/peer support and SUD Systems into the transformation process. Lisa shared the history of the ROSC transformation. Lisa presented and passed out the first draft of a document entitled, *Framework and Infrastructure for Recovery Oriented Systems of Care and Individual Recovery Initiatives*, and explained each section of the document to the group, relating to the group her observation that SAMHSA’s guidelines and the SUD plan overlap. SAMHSA’s definition has been adopted. She also explained the purpose of this document is to help us build a behavioral health recovery/ROSC system. The ROSC/TSC participants asked questions and offered ideas. Lisa encouraged the participants to review the guidelines in the document and if there is a feeling that something else needs to be added, or changed to contact her. The draft document will be e-mailed to the participants who are attending through conference call.

Discussion continued that produced a list of additions to the *draft Framework and Infrastructure for ROSC and Individual Initiatives*. Further discussion about the remainder of the document. Discussion will continue at the next meeting.
