SUMMARY OF KEY POINTS	
<p><b>Welcome and Introductions:</b> Minou Carey opened the meeting by thanking members for attending, followed by introductions.</p> <p><b>Approval of Minutes:</b> The minutes of March 17, 2011, were approved with several revisions.</p> <p><b>Summary of Agenda Items:</b> Larry Scott reported that BSAAS is in the process of completing the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant (SAPT BG) application. He also mentioned that this year, states were given the option of integrating and submitting mental health into their SAPT BG application. However, Michigan is integrated structurally, and not functionally, therefore applications will be submitted separately.</p> <p>Sgt. Roberta Williams presented an overview of National Guard efforts with regard to RxOTC drug abuse. She addressed the issue from the supply and demand side, and offered an evidence-based program called “Stay on Track” for students in grades six through eight. This is a 12-week program, to increase a students’ knowledge about RxOTC drug abuse.</p> <p>Brenda Stoneburner shared data and maps from the Office of Applied Studies, National Survey on Drug Use and Health (NSDUH) from 2007 and 2008 on the non-medical use of pain relievers in the past year (2010), with a breakdown according to the following age groups: persons 12 years-of-age or older; 12 to 17 years-of-age; 18 to 25 years-of-age; and 26 years-of-age and older. Based on this data, Michigan’s rate for those years was 5.42 percent. The Office of National Drug Control Policy’s (ONDCP) goal is for each state to reduce their rate by 15 percent. For Michigan, this would mean a 4.61 percent drop in the use of RxOTC drug abuse. A question was asked as to whether it would be possible to get data through connections with prescription drug use and other health indicators.</p> <p>Ms. Carey shared a document with the group from ONDCP, entitled, <i>Epidemic: Responding to America’s Prescription Drug Abuse Crisis</i>, released earlier in the week. Members were asked to review in more detail prior to the next meeting. Members were also asked to think about how to link items in the document to the Michigan plan.</p>

Ms. Carey will assist in the selection of the appropriate schools in high target areas.</li> <li>2. Brenda will inform Dr. Oh that the request has been made to provide data on the connection between prescription drug use and other health indicators, and will find out what is available to share at a future meeting.</li> <li>3. RxOTC Abuse Workgroup members to conduct a more in-depth review of the ONDCP document, <i>Epidemic: Responding to America’s Prescription Drug Abuse Crisis</i>, and be ready to share how this document links to the Michigan plan at the next meeting.</li> </ol>
